LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES

The 110th league of California Cities Annual Conference was held in Long Beach, with Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger addressing attendees in a special session held on Thursday, September 25. More than 1,800 city officials attended the conference at the Long Beach Convention Center. At the closing session, the League of California Cities announced its election of new officers; and the board of directors, including Shalice Reynoso as the City Clerk Department Director, was sworn into office.

The new board of directors will hold its first meeting on November 21-22, 2008 at the Fairmont Newport Beach. The agenda includes the annual strategic planning in preparation of work programs for the coming year, the 2009 proposed budget, and other important League issues.

LEGISLATION

The California State Legislature stands in final recess. The 2007-2008 regular biennial legislative session will officially end at midnight on November 30, 2008, upon *sine die* adjournment.

The 2009-2010 regular legislative session will officially convene at noon on December 1, 2008.

All bills signed by the Governor prior to October 2, 2008 will take effect on January 1, 2009.
